INTERNATIONAL MISSION RADIO ASSOCIATION

Mary Lou, WD8KHO has been a member of the IMRA since 1968, when she went to work in Recife, Brazil. Mary Lou would like to recruit new members to join the daily net. The radio operator sees mission radio activity as a vital service in supplying the needs of mankind. The IMRA has 350 members in 40 countries. A "traffic" net is held daily at 14.280 MHZ from 1900 to 2000 GMT. Messages requesting help from people, especially missionaries, are handled, and volunteer services are offered to all people, regardless of religious denomination.

The ministry of amateur radio communication reaches, through radio waves into the poorest & most needy areas. One days' traffic may include dispatching medicine to a burned child in the jungle, via air; rescue of victims of hurricanes and floods, projects involving doctors who visit underdeveloped areas to give medical aid, or dentists, who take a week off to give service in some remote spot. EXPLANATION OF BALLOT ON BY-LAW CHANGES

We hate to burden you with another ballot this year, but it is most necessary. With our non-profit rating secured, it is imperative that we propose a dues increase. We also, wish to correct an omission in the last by-law change!

BY-LAWS - Article I -Membership -- Sec. 1.

The sentence on ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP now reads; ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP shall be open to all women who meet the general membership qualifications, but who reside outside the U.S. or Canada.

CHANGE this sentence to read; ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP shall be open to all women who meet the general membership qualifications but who reside outside the U.S.

REASON: This simply deletes the words "or Canada". This minor change was overlooked on the last revisions that were made to bring our BY-LAWS in agreement with what our Incorporation Papers require.
