# A Salute To Our Founders

YLRL is proud and happy, on the occasion of its 30th Anniversary, to re-affirm its gratitude to, and its affection for its Founding Members - the 12 YLs who answered the letter from Ethel, K4LMB (then W7FWB up in the state of Washington). This letter was a follow-up of an ad in the May 1939 issue of QST which asked just how many YL "key-twitchers" there might be.



This was the original group: W1GQT, W5HYF, W6RGX, W7GXI, W8SBB, W8TAY, W9CHD (now W6NAZ), W9NBX (now W6UXF), W9NLW, W9UA (now WØUA), W9WWP (now W6WSV), VE2HI, and Ethel, W7FWB. In no time at all they were organized, and a YLRL Constitution was adopted in October 1939.

When Ethel wrote her letter, she said in part, "Perhaps we should band together in a YLRL or something to that effect..." - and that's just what happened. And here we are - celebrating the 30th Birthday of that YLRL that began so casually. We are fortunate to be in touch with most of these Charter Members and proudly devote this section to bringing their stories up to date.

Ethel has been married for the past nine years to Tex DeBardeleben - W4TE - but she still uses her maiden name because most people have some trouble pronouncing Tex's name. They live on a nice little "antenna farm" on top of the highest hill in the county. Ethel runs a Drake TR-4, plus a Clegg Zeus on 6 and 2 - with 6 and 10 meter rigs for mobile. Tex retired a little over a year ago from the F.C.C., and now keeps himself busy with hamming and yard work. He is active on traffic nets.

Ethel is now looking forward to retirement in 1972 from an interesting but demanding 30-year career as a Research Specialist with the Navy Scientific and Technical Intelligence Center in Washington. In spite of this heavy schedule, she never has given up her amateur radio activities, which have included participation in local radio clubs, AREC (Sec. Emerg. Coordinator for State of Virginia), NTS traffic nets on both SSB and CW, Navy MARS - NØADP - Quarter Century Wireless Association, Northern Virginia Radio Club, and is a WAYLARC trustee to the Foundation for Amateur Radio. She says she does a good deal of yard work and holds a minor office in Eastern Star. She's a member of YLRL, too, y'know - hi!

The W7FWB call was issued to Ethel in 1936, and she holds an Advanced Class license. She also held W3MSU. She was, of course, YLRL's very first President, and then served as Treasurer in 1957. The home QTH of the De Bardelebens is McLean, VA, and the phone is 703-536-8469. Ethel's birthday is Feb 13.

YLRL is proud of Ethel and hopes she has seen her fondest hopes for the organization largely realized. Thanks again, Ethel, for having that good idea back in '39!

Enid Aldwell (nee Carter)-W6UXF (ex-W9NBX)- became the second President of YLRL after serving as Secy-Treas. and Editor of the paper, first called "YL News" but changed with the second issue (Dec. 1939) to YL HARMONICS. She was active for many years in both YLRL and YLRC of LA (Charter member). Her Advanced Class license dates from 1935, and she enjoys membership in the Quarter Century Wireless Association.

When Enid's OM became a Silent Key several years ago, she took a good look at her life and, after special work at UCLA, embarked on a successful writing career - always on subjects to help others to fuller and more rewarding lives. She lists her occupation as Marriage Counselor, and is now associated with the Institute of Christian Counseling. Her work involves working with individuals, married couples, and groups, as well as conducting workshops.

Enid has a charming little book of verse now in paperback form, called "Inside Story," of which she says, "It is really a book of feelings. Others tell me as they read they find that they are reading about their own feelings." Copies of the book may be ordered from Enid for \$1.25 (incl. tax & postage).

Lida King - W1GQT - enjoys the distinction of having been the first District Chairman for 1-land! She held the job two terms, and says it was very pleasant hearing from the various YL seach month.

Lida says it doesn't seem possible that thirty years have gone by since YLRL began, andwhen we read of her activities today we realize why time never did hang heavy at her QTH. She and OM Jim-WlEVZ-still run their store in Holyoke where they specialize in TV antennas and accessories - 6 days a week, 9 to 5:30. After that, the usual household chores - Lida says she's considering a light on the lawn -mower so she can work later - hi!

All this activity gives little time for hamming, but her wonderful, warm letter leaves no doubt that, since that Advanced Class ticket arrived in 1933, radio has been a big part of her life and that her thoughts are with us. Jim has not been

too well of late years, and our sincere wish is that he will soon improve - and perhaps retirement time will come and we'll again hear them both on the air.



Ethel - VE2HI

Ethel Pick - VE2HI - is our one and only Canadian founder - and she must have been plugging all these years to see a Canadian YLRL President - a reality in 1970 - hi!

In her letter, Ethel tells how in 1932 a friend installed a receiver in her summer cottage. Then he talked "at" her each evening and, being a YL, she was so irked at not being able to talk back that by the summer of 1933 she had her call VE2HI and a rig at the lake. But it wasn't quite as easy as it sounds, because there was no electricity available there at that time - so they installed their own power house, with the engine of an old Starr Continental car, the generator out of a submarine, and a transformer from the Westmount Light, Heat and Power Co. -

enough electricity for a village - hi! Ethel enjoyed CW for many years, and in 1939 when war broke out and amateurs were off the air, she joined a volunteer group working for the air force and army teaching code to volunteers and C.O.T.C. groups - the only woman in the group.

After the war, Ethel became a ham again - and gradually a "phone addict" - her words - hi! Since 1949 she has been Secy of the Montreal ARC, and helps put out their monthly magazine MARCOGRAM to their 300 members. She usually is on twice a day with the P.L. (Professional Loafers) Net - in fact, she is about as active as a ham can be. She enjoyed the Midwest YL Convention in Toronto where she won a prize for being the oldest ham present - always a YL to us, though.

Ethel taught school for many years, and on retiring was asked to take over the Library in a private Boys' School, where she still works three days a week. She also loves to travel and has covered most of the U.S., Canada, Hawaii and the Caribbean - and just this year enjoyed a month in England and Scotland. What a gal!

Anita Bien - W8TAY (W4JCR for awhile) - was YLRL's first Publicity Chairman and secured a good amount of coverage for the YLs, with the first big feature-length article in May 1940 QST. Anita's enthusiasm and energy make her a natural-born booster, and she has given very generously of her time and efforts for YLRL.... holding the Publicity job from '39 through '45.

Anita was President of YLRL in 1942, and also edited the paper. This was in the difficult war years when the YLs did such a good job of keeping YLRL alive although no one was on the air.

Then there were the 10 years spent in Florida as W4JCR - a charter member of Floridoras, and 4th D/C were part of this era. When her OM Frank, W4JCS/W8SSV, became a Silent Key,





Anita received her license on her birthday, March 1, 1939, and has put it to good use winning many service awards as well as contributing much to the YL picture - most recently as a member of Buckeye Belles. And she doesn't let up for a minute - right now she's working as a free-lance writer and is taking a two-year course in Communications. Other hobbies are photography, oil painting and gourmet cooking. She says she's unable to operate at this time from her apartment-type QTH, but we know she's there just the same through her wonderful letters that express her continuing interest in YLs and YLRL. We can always depend on Anita for early YLRL facts and figures from her fabulous file so carefully preserved all these years. And it was a distinct pleasure to meet this tiny but powerful YL in Denver.

Loretta Ensor - WOUA. Few today remember when there were no YL radio operators ----Loretta, the first Midwest YL, has continued on the air since 1923 when she became 9UA while attending Olathe High School so the school might have a permanent station the first in Kansas! And today she seldom misses a schedule of the YL Javhawker Net!

Most of her\_operating was done from the home station built by her brother. WØBSP.

Equipment was all assembled in the early days...with a gasoline-engine driven high voltage generator - which had to be hand cranked each time before coming on the air. From this station, her first contact was 9RR, a spark station in Kansas City, Mo.

In giving code lessons over the air from 1929 to 1941, Loretta helped many to become YL operators. In 1939, YL interest was strong, YLRL was formed, and Loretta was right there! When the 9th District was divided, she was appointed the first D/C for the new District ... and the name YL Harmonics received its origin from her suggestion.

Loretta says that keeping the old farm operating is becoming a chore, since time has a way of catching up on all of us so we don't move as fast as we once did. But she has enjoyed working on the project of assembling a fine collection of relics of the past radio equipment used at the station and has several interesting displays set up in the farm barn.

Other 'specs' on Loretta are that she held 9UA and W9UA before becoming W\$UA; her ticket is Advanced Class; her brother Marshall is W\$BSP; her birthday is Apr 22; occupation, farming; hobbies: antiques of family and needlework.

If you are in the vicinity of Olathe, Kans. sometime, why not give Loretta a call at Spring Hill 686-3463 and let her show you the interesting radio display?

Lenore Kingston Jensen -W6NAZ - who, of course, is W9CHD on our list of Founders, could possibly be our busiest YL! In fact, she comes pretty close to disproving the old law of Physics which says we can't occupy more than one place at a time - hi! We turn on the TV - she's there: we turn on our rig - there's the familiar voice...but one thing is sure - wherever she is, she's doing a good job, and chances are it's a public service of some kind.



Lenore - W6NAZ

At present, Army MARS Vietnam patching is routine at Lenore's QTH; and a while back she organized a f.b. system of phone patches for the lonely service men who visit the USOs in this area - to put them in touch with home during the period when they are trying to adjust to a different type of life. In addition, Lenore is a reader for "Recordings for the Blind."

Lenore's Advanced Class license dates from 1939 in 9-land. Soon thereafter she moved to New York City where she helped found the NYC YLRL in 1942 as W2NAZ. She was active throughout the war years with code classes and other volunteer work. Around 1946 she came to Los Angeles, became W6NAZ, and joined the brand-new YLRC of LA, of which she is still a member. Lenore is now married to Bob Jensen, W6VGQ, an audio engineer for NBC. Bob has a daughter Cindy, WN6MQI; and son Steve, W6RHM.

Lenore - actress, writer, and a wonderful YL, served as Vice President of YLRL in 1947-48; was 2nd D/C in 1946; and was the Editor of our first two Directories. Her birthday is Oct 4.

Marjorie Frazier - W7GXI - received her Conditional Class license in 1938, and we'd guess her brother, Mace, W7GUJ, probably interested her in the hobby, because her OM Arnold is not a ham.

Located in Oroville, Wash. just below the Canadian border, Marjorie has not been within range of the YL clubs - and the Convention at Denver seemed to be a special treat for her. Sorry we did not get a picture good enough for reproduction - but at least we did have the opportunity to meet and enjoy her.

Marjorie served as 7th D/C in 1958; lists her occupation as housewife and Beekeeper and her hobbies as Knitting and Crocheting. If you are ever lucky enough to visit up there in the beautiful Okanogan country, give her a call at 509-476-2268 and see about an eyelash QSO. Her birthday is Dec 31.

Carol Anne Witte - W6WSV - was Carol Keating - W9WWP - when she received her Advanced Class license in 1936. She was YLRL's first Vice President and Activities Mgr. During WWII we find Carol in the Navy where she served in several capacities - she changed her name to Witte about this time, too, when she married Dick, W6WSW. After the war, the Wittes

settled in the Los Angeles area where Carol became a charter member and the first President of the YLRC of LA. She is a CW operator only, and a fine one.

A few years ago Carolembarked on a teaching career in Tustin H.S., but the hoped-for challenge was lacking; so now she is taking graduate work at U.C. at Riverside with college-level teaching her goal. Needless to say, all this has kept her off the air.

Carol and Dick have a daughter, Marcie, who is a college Senior; and a son, Mike, a Senior in high school. Dick is employed at Beckman Industries in Fullerton, gets on the air once in a while, and secured his Extra Class license last year. This might be contagious, we hope, and we might hear Carol on the air again one of these days. Carol lists her occupation as Homemaker/Teacher, and her birthday Nov 18.

Of the other four Founding Members, two are still members in good standing, but did not return the information forms. Unfortunately, the other two have been lost to us for some time, and we hope they will be located some day - no doubt with new calls, and possibly new names.

Jean Burkhead, W9NLW - lives in Champaign, Ill., but, as she was not written up in the last special Directory ('61), we have no information.

Mary Stocking - W8SBB - is now Mary Bamberg - K4UBT - in Clearwater, Fla. Perhaps someone there can tell us more about her - or maybe Mary herself will relent when she sees this and get in touch - hi!

Jean Doss - W5HYF - appears in several places as 5th D/C - always in Texas, including the cities of Happy (while serving as our very first 5th D/C), Amarillo in 1948, and Paducah in 1949.

Genevieve Capstaff - W6RGX - of Van Nuys, Calif. was active as the first 6th D/C, but we find nothing to indicate that she picked up her license after WWII.

### AND SOME MISSED THE BOAT

Like some of our ancestors who didn't quite get their baggage aboard the Mayflower, many YLs joined YLRL immediately after its founding - in fact, the Dec. 1939 issue of Harmonics listed 24 members. By May 1940 the membership had grown to 99; and by November 1941 there were 235. Many of these YLs are still with us, and we value their contributions through the years. The problems of tracing changed calls and names, and the fear of omitting some who should be included, makes it impossible to list them at this time - we just wouldn't know where to stop. So we have limited this to the original 13. CQ-YL has a most comprehensive history of these long-time members, and if you haven't read it you should.

Congratulations to the following YLs who will be at the helm for 1970.

## 1969 DIRECTORY of the YOUNG LADIES RADIO LEAGUE

This is a very large Directory, and it was necessary to save space in every possible way. To this end, the personal data is run in a code form, which really is not too difficult to read if you just relax and take it as it comes - hi! Here's how it works:

Listings are alphabetized by calls, as in Callbook, with some crossreferences to take care of recent changes. Each YL's call is followed by her name and address, and her telephone number in parentheses. Then comes a code consisting of numbers and letters, something like this: A 57 58 Apr 10, meaning that she holds an Advanced Class ticket, was licensed in 1957, joined YLRL in 1958, and her birthday is April 10. After this is her occupation, the YLRL offices and appointments she has held, and her YL Club affiliation. Then comes her OM's name and call, followed by the calls, names and relationships of other hams in her family. Finally, a brief listing of her interests other than amateur radio, and perhaps other pertinent information. If any of the data is not given, it is because it was not sent in and could not easily be run down.

Unfortunately, only a few more than half our members returned the information sheets sent out in the March-April YLH, so all others are listed with call, name and address only.

This Directory has been brought up to date as far as possible, and supersedes all other lists of YLRL members.

Naturally, in a work this size there will be errors - I know I didn't always get the information in the right order, for instance. So if you find an error which is important, please notify the Editor so it can be run as Feedback - if not too important, just forgive me.

The Directory comes to you as a sort of Birthday Gift on YLRL's 30th Anniversary, from Marte, KPEPE, our 1969 President - who wanted it to the extent that she even offered to make up the difference in cost between this and a regular edition of YLH! What happens to "the best-laid plans of mice and men" happened to us this time for sure. The re-balloting on the Constitutional change prevented the planned inclusion of the Constitution in this issue (to make a nice package of Membership List and Constitution for our new members); and then some unexpected and unavoidable circumstances at the Editor's QTH delayed publication greatly. In the meantime, Marte - bless her - came through with her lively News Letter to save the day and give you some of the information which would be woefully late in the Directory.

Also, because this issue had to be double the size of a regular issue to accommodate the Directory, and because time ran out on us, the Sept-Oct issue was omitted, and the Nov-Dec issue is well on its way.

Score two (2) points for each contact with a station not located within an ARRL Section. (i.e. DX) Definition of DX: all stations not located within an ARRL Section. DX YLs shall score two (2) points for each contact with a station located in an ARRL Section. Score one (1) point for each contact with another DX station. (Note: Please know your ARRL section. Section lists are available from Vice President. Send S.A.S.E. to receive list.) Multiply number of contact points by total number of different ARRL Sections and/or Countries worked. Note re ARRL Sections: The Maritimes include: New Brunswick, VE1; Nova Scotia, VE1; Prince Edward Island, VE1; and Newfoundland, VO1 and VO2.
- C. Contestants running 150 watts, or less, DC input at all times, may multiply the results of (B) by 1.25 (low power multiplier).
- D. SSB contestants running 300 P.E.P. or less at all times may use the low power multiplier. (Results of B by 1.25)

#### TAKE A LOOK AT YOUR OWN QSL CARDS

QSLing is, as it says in the book, "the final courtesy in a QSO." But, in addition to this, these cards often mean a great deal to the recipient as credit toward various awards. And, sometimes, because the cards have become such a familiar item around the shack, we forget just what they should convey-and do not always realize that for some awards the information is critically examined before credit is given. So why not be sure YOUR card is adequate for any purpose-not a disappointment to the YL or OM who receives it...not the one which has to be sent back for correction?

If you meet the following requirements you'll be on the safe side:

- 1. Include wording such as "confirmation of QSO" to indicate a two-way contact. Some like to see 2xSSB for a SSB contact.
- 2. Call and address of the station worked. And if you send the card in an envelope, be sure address is also on the card, as most awards require the contacts from the same or a nearby address.
- 3. Name of the operator you worked. (First name is sufficient)
- 4. Your own call letters (preferably on both sides of card).
- 5. Your full name, as in the Callbook. (Usually printed on the card-and easier to read than your signature.) Remember that for YLCC, the list must be alphabetical by last names.
- Correct address of your station. (County, ARRL Section and Zone # are usually appreciated, though not required.)
- 7. Your signature whatever you are called on the air.
- 8. Frequency used for contact at least the band.
- 9. Mode of operation CW, AM, SSB, RTTY, etc.
- 10. Signal report and date and time of contact.

No erasures or other alterations are permitted for many awards, so if you goof in making out a card, please have the courtesy to discard it and use another correct one. Most cards will tell station equipment, etc., as this is of interest to many operators, and award hunters will appreciate seeing your affiliations to indicate the eligibility of the contact for certain awards. Many cards are lacking in one or more of the above, through oversight - or because the sender is not particularly interested in awards and doesn't realize the importance of a complete card. Let's send out good cards that will keep everyone happy! Ham and let Ham - hi! 33, Maxine - WA6AOE

The above is a repeat from an old issue, at the request of Onie-W1ZEN, YLCC Certif. Custodian, who must check over hundreds of cards each year. While we're at it, we might as well consider some other points not previously included. Now, don't throw out all your cards or give up QSLing - hi! But for those who find it time to order new cards: please consider the size of the card. The P.O. is working toward the standardization of all card and envelope sizes, and has already outlawed some. So have your cards standard postcard size. Until you have tried to wrap a bundle of cards for YLCC containing a couple of out-size cards, you may not appreciate this..but they either either must be cut down or folded, and are ruined thereby. And most operators keep QSL cards in standard sized files - and out-size cards just won't fit, and will probably wind up out in the cold. Another thing to consider: most of the popular and sought-after DX stations who have long lists of cards to send out will appreciate a card with all the information on one side - in fact, some refuse to flip them at all...and you are the loser. At least, if the vital information is on the back of the card, be sure your call letters are there, too. 'Nuff sed. Happy QSLing!




#### YL OPEN HOUSE NET
