

## CONVENTION ECHOS

Friday, June 17th the 3rd International YLRL CONVENTION began at the Commander Hotel, at Harvard Square, Cambridge, Mass. Early arrivals took in historic sights and attended a party in the home of W1QON in Walpole Thursday evening. Friday afternoon and evening YLs and OMs enjoyed visiting and getting acquainted at the YLRL Suite 229, and enjoyed the hospitality of the WRONES. Some operated amateur radio station W1YL, using the call issued by FCC especially for the Convention. YE OLDE WRONE GIFT SHOPPE was a pleasant place to browse for unusual gifts. The real center of attraction was the much publicized YLRL Bedspread.

Saturday morning the OMs went on a conducted tour to the Radio Shack and to Millstone Observatory. Meanwhile, the YLs had their business session and luncheon. Speakers included: W1ZEN, Convention Chairman; W1HOY, Emcee of the YLRL FORUM; W6DXI, YLRL President; W5EGD/3, YLRL Vice President; W5RZJ, "CQ" YL Editor; W1QON, "QST" YL Editor; K4LMB, Founder of YLRL; OH5SM, Finland; and W4HWR/2 recently from Japan. W1ZEN, Onie, read a letter of greeting from K6ENK, Wanda expressing her regret in not being able to attend the Convention. W6DXI, Gladys reported that we currently had 827 members and were \$1,809 rich, AND THAT YLRL'S Incorporation was virtually complete. She suggested that we consider a permanent custodian of the YL/OM Contest and the YLAP since both contests are so big the V.D. just understands them, then her time is up. A UHF Contest in the Spring was suggested. W9GME, WAS/YL Custodian pointed out the Certificate still reads "48 States". It was voted to have new Certificates printed and they will be retroactive for an YL or OM who has worked WAS/YL since the 50 state rule has been effective.

W5EGD/3, Lillian reported the AP would be the latter part of October this year to avoid the Christmas rush in checking logs and that the CW portion will be first for a change. She said there will probably be another HOWDY WEEK in September. She stressed the need for permanent rules for the YLRL Contests and possibly limiting them to 24 hours.

W5RZJ, Louisa gave a report on the progress of "CQ YL", stating that she had sold 465 copies reducing her indebtedness from \$2,000 to \$200. (Those who have not purchased a copy, please do so to help Louisa get out of the red. You'll not be sorry--the book is super!!) Louisa suggested YLRL consider a permanent Headquarters for YLRL with paid help to get "Harmonics" out. The size of the organization, compiling, editing, etc. printing, assembling, mailing have made it too much for one gal! Wanda has been doing a magnificent job, she said, and we should all express our deep gratitude to her but should not expect her to go on doing it indefinitely without help.

The girls were thrilled to have two long time YLs present at the Convention. W1ZR and W1HUH,

At the Luncheon each YL rcvd a plastic bag filled with all sorts of surprises and a beautiful pair of ear rings of copper and ceramic with YLRL inscribed upon them. Many prizes were given at the Luncheon with the grand prize -- a Hallicrafters SX-111 Receiver going to W1YPT, Leona. Decorations included glittered letters of YLRL, a big red felt lobster, a Miss WRONE of styra-foam and cardboard--the table decorations were scenes depicting each N.E. state at the head table, lobster shack for Maine, Beanpot house for Mass, skiing scene for N.H., etc. On the other tables were scenes from other call areas and Canada, Finland, Hawaii, etc. W6 land was a redwood, with a car wid whip going thru it and a sign Boston--miles.

Both YLs and OMs enjoyed the banquet Saturday evening. Favors were pins made of acorns and pine cones (WRONE emblem) for YLs and tie bars of Air Dux Coils for the OMs. Father Dan Linehan, W1HWK, Director of Weston Observatory, was the speaker presenting his scientific travels to Antarctica from a "Ham's Eye View", illustrating with beautiful colored slides.

The long-awaited hour of the bedspread drawing arrived only to bring keen disappointment to the YLS--their beautiful bedspread went to an OM, W1NUP--AN A BACHELOR AT THAT!! The 2nd prize--a hand made hairpin lace afghan, also went to an OM, K1HUI. Many prizes were awarded with the grand-prize, a Tapetone VHF Skysweep Rcvr going to Mrs. Marie Emmons, mother of W6UEA. K5BNQ rcvd a souvenir apron for being the YL with the most YL Club certificates.

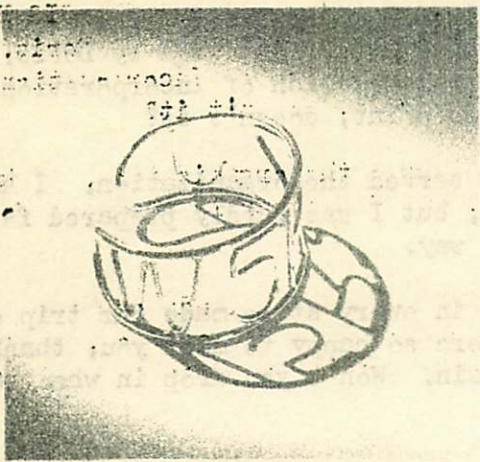

"HOWDY DAYS" will be Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday this year. Wednesday, Sept. 28th, Thursday, Sept. 29th and Friday, Sept. 30th, 1960.

This is not a contest to say "hello" and "goodbye" all in one breath, then sign off. It is a get-acquainted, fun party for licensed YLs. Meet all your old friends and make new ones. Help new YLs on the air to join in the fun, and extend them a welcome to join YLRL and its activities. Those of you who operate contests could give helpful information to those who have never been in a contest, especially stressing contests sponsored by YLRL.

The following are rules for HOWDY DAYS --

1. Score will be based on licensed YL contacts only.
  2. All bands and all modes of emissions may be used.
  3. Only one contact for a station may be claimed.
  4. Contacts on Nets not permitted.
  5. No multipliers.
  6. Contest opens 12 Noon EST. Wednesday, September 28, and closes 12 noon EST Friday, September 30, 1960.
  7. Scoring - 2 points for YLRL member. 1 point for Non-member YL.
  8. Logs not required. Submit a list, stating date, time, call, name, QTH, YLRL member or not.
  9. Awards - Top YLRL member score - choice of Pin or YLRL stationery.  
Top non-member score - one year paid membership in YLRL.
  10. Score sheets must be received by Vice President of YLRL by October 15, 1960. You will notice there is not too much time allowed, so send those lists as soon as you can after contest.
  11. Submit scores to: Lillian E. Beebe, W5EGD/3, Vice President YLRL, 923 Kent Ave., Baltimore 28, Maryland. Be sure zone number is included with address.
- P.S. It is suggested that all YL NETS close for these three days. That, of course, will be up to all Net Control Stations of each Net. Giving contacts on a Net adds confusion.

Have fun! Hope I will be able to join you all from here in Maryland.

## 21st YLRL ANNIVERSARY PARTY

Time: CW - Start, October 19, 1960, 12 Noon EST. End, October 20, 6:00 p.m. EST  
Phone - Start, November 2, 1960, 12 Noon EST. End, November 3, 6:00 p.m. EST

### Eligibility:

All licensed YL and XYL operators throughout the world are invited to participate. YLRL members are eligible for the cup awards, non-members receive certificates. ONLY YLRL members are eligible for the Corcoran Award. Contacts with OMs will not count. There will also be a special certificate offered to the highest scoring Novice operator. There will be a special certificate offered to the highest scoring technician operator.

### Operation:

All bands may be used. Cross-band operation is not permitted. Only one contact with each station will be counted in each contest.

### Procedure:

Call "CQ YLAP"

### Exchange:

Station worked, QSO number, RS or RST report, ARRL section, U.S. Possession, VE District or country. Entries in your log should also state the band you were working at time of contacts, power, time of contacts, and date.

### Scoring:

- (a) CW and PHONE sections will be scored as separate contests.
- (b) Multiply number of contacts by the total number of ARRL sections, U.S. possessions, VE districts and countries worked.
- (c) Contestants running 150 watts input or less at all times may multiply the results of (b) by 1.25 (Low Power Multiplier).

### Awards:

Highest CW Score- Gold Cup                      Highest Phone score,- Gold Cup  
Top three scores in each contest will receive certificates.  
Highest CW and PHONE score in each ARRL section, U.S. Possession, VE District, and country will receive a certificate.  
Highest combined PHONE and CW score, YLRL member, will receive Corcoran Award.

### Logs:

Copies of all logs must show claimed score and be postmarked not later than November 19, 1960, and received by the Vice President of YLRL, not later than November 30, 1960, or they will be disqualified. Send copies of log to: Lillian E. Beebe, W5EGD/3, 923 Kent Avenue, Baltimore 28, Maryland. Be sure zone number is included in address.

No logs will be returned. Be sure it is a copy of log you send in for confirmation.

REMEMBER ----- THE CW PORTION OF YLAP COMES FIRST THIS YEAR-----

SUGGESTION-----Don't be afraid of the CW portion of the Contest. Listen for the YLs--- call them at the speed they are sending and when you go back to them keep that speed. Don't call slowly and then go back 30 WPM---they may be out of practice on the key---let's all cooperate with each other. Maybe this will help more YLs get their "feet wet" and encourage them to operate on the CW bands.

A DAUGHTER OF W R O N E

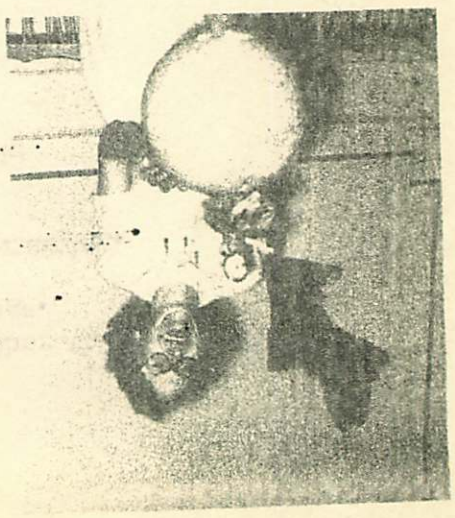
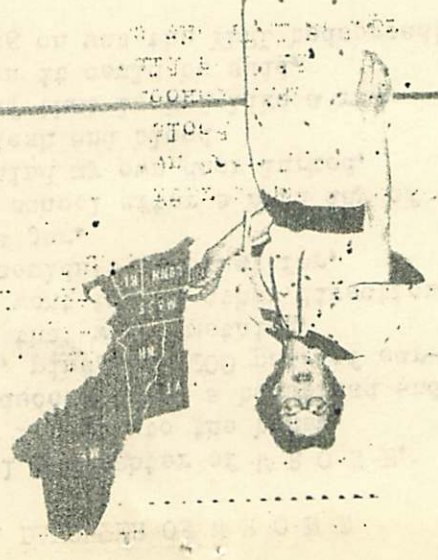
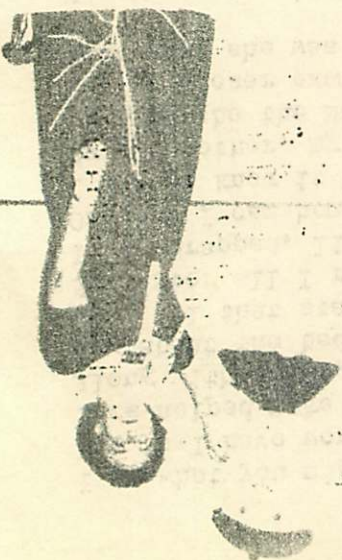
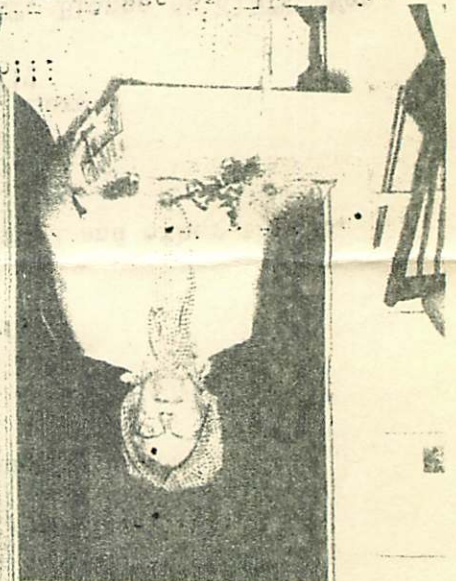
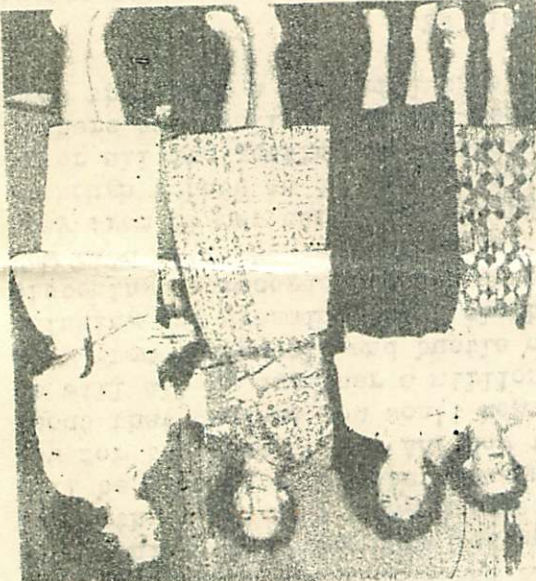
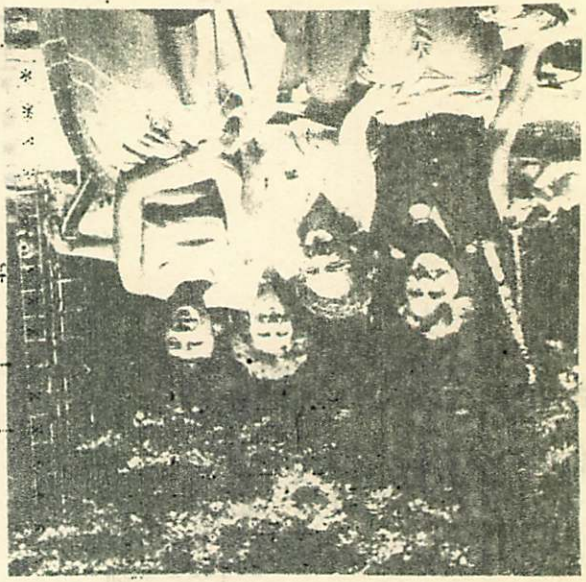
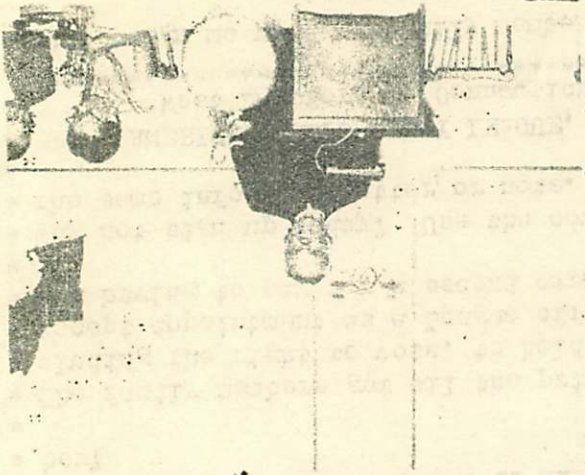
I am what you might call a daughter of W R O N E.
