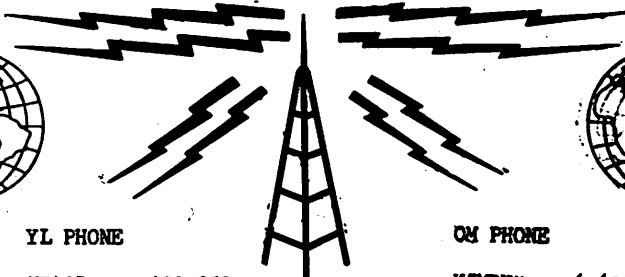

WN0GMC-Carole. OM is John WB0DLL. Has a 2 year old who thinks he would be a good op, too. Birthday is July 17th.

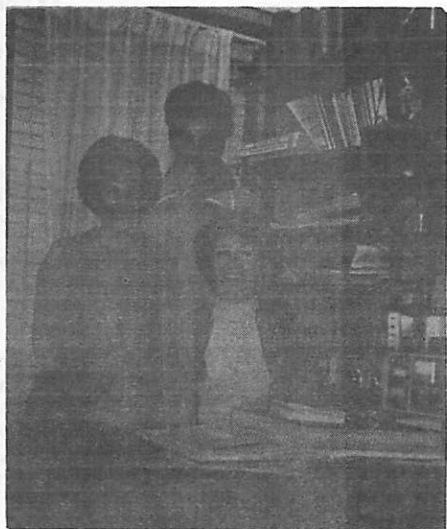
