Election returns were again very few. At the time of elections we had a voting membership of 758; only 47% voted! Below is the membership by districts and the percentage that voted in each district:

563% I will answer some of the questions that were asked along with the 54 % return of the ballots. K6LPH, Patti, was the first one to return her 52 43 % 3 37 ballot. You were requested to put your name and call in the upper 4 50 % 82 left hand corner of the envelope. We prefer that you do not sign 56 562% 92 your ballot; if the name and call are on the envelope, I can check 119 57 % to be sure that you are eligible to vote and then the ballot is 78 53 % 73 separated from the envelope and it is impossible to know how one 39 % 74 voted. A couple of ballots had to be thrown out because I had no 9ø 413% 84 way of knowing who had sent them because they were not signed and 45 40 % no return address. Three ballots were mailed after the deadline of 7 KH 43 % Aug. 15, so they too had to be thrown out. Most girls were very 44 % KL 9 prompt and ballots came in early. Just keep urging people to vote 100 % KZ 1 and maybe they will realize the importance of voting and we can VE 14 29 % have a better return.






