A couple of ballots had to be thrown out because I had no way of knowing who had sent them because they were not signed and no return address. Three ballots were mailed after the deadline of Aug. 15, so they too had to be thrown out. Most girls were very prompt and ballots came in early. 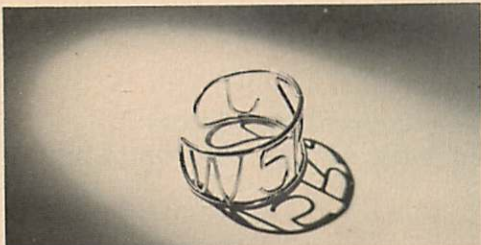

Worked 139 Countries (103 on 21 mc) DXCC 110. MM Club Certificates for working about 50 ships (first European YL to gain this Certificate). Only need Zone 19 for WAZ. I would like to see the whole Amateur World give really low power a good try out--especially the USA Section, hi. I do believe the DX results would be surprising, with a quarter of the present QRM and selfish operating of many of the VFOs, hi. I want to thank W1TIW Sally for so kindly sponsoring me to

YLRL membership. Sally and I correspond from time to time but we are both too QRL to write often. Sorry I don't know G2YL, G3MER, G8LY or G3LWY, but use to correspond with G2YL & G8LY pre-war. 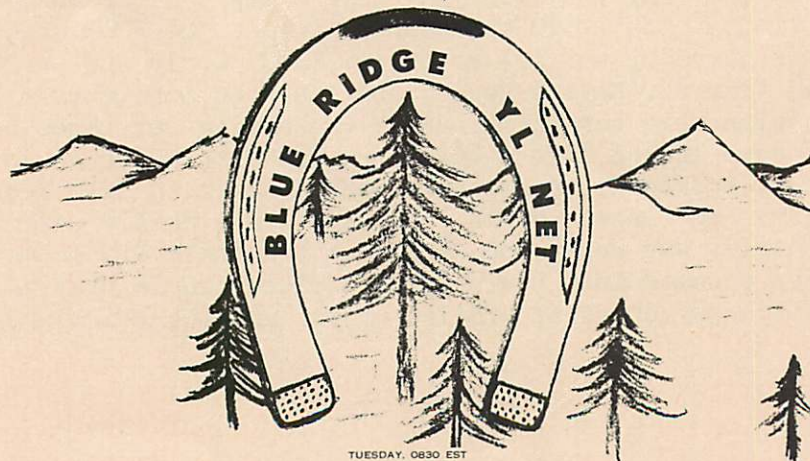
Sunday the Blue Ridge Net Certificate (pictured here) was presented to the girls for approval.

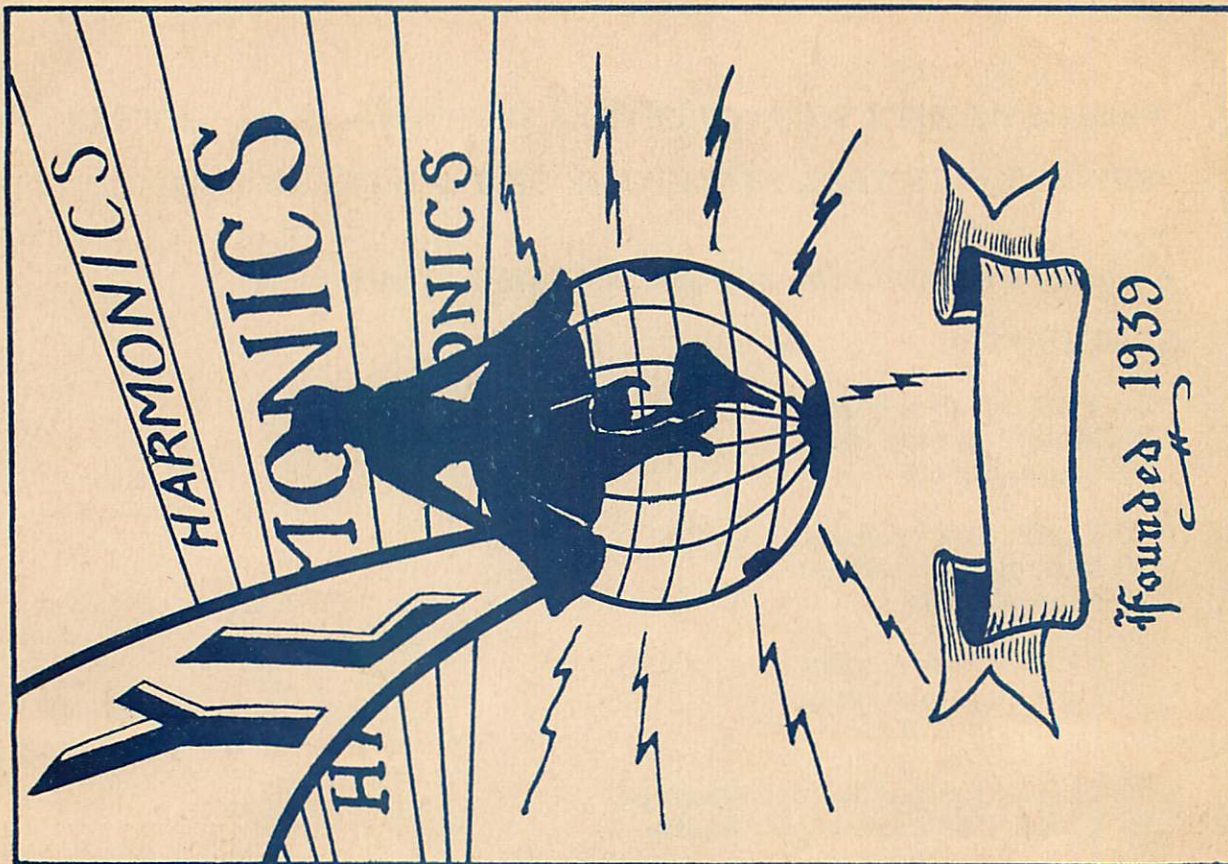
