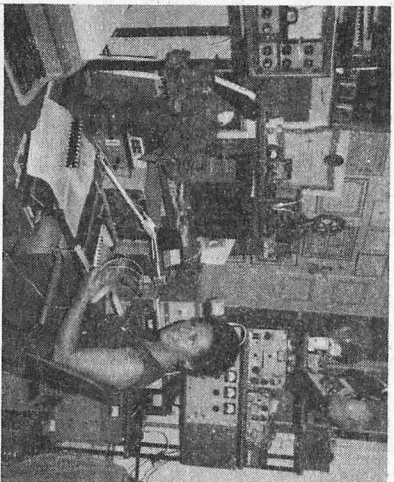

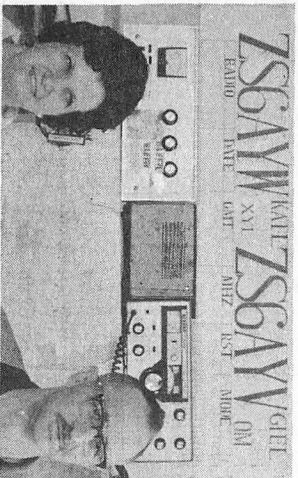

The problems of television sets receiving signals from ham radio stations with proper harmonic suppression is caused by the lack of proper filters within the TV sets themselves. The responsibility for correction of said problem is between the TV owner and the manufacturer of his set. It is the responsibility of the owner of the TV set to install the filter on his own set, or have it installed by his local television repairman. This filter should not be installed by the licensed amateur operator.

This filter will not prevent harmonics from the amateur's set from interferin with normal TV reception.
