KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the Corporations Code of the State of California,

AND THAT WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation is:

YOUNG LADIES' RADIO LEAGUE, INC.

SECOND: The primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To further cooperation among women radio amateurs; to develop proficiency in the art of amateur radio operation, and to further the interest of amateur radio.

In addition to the primary purposes, the corporation shall have the following general purposes or powers:

To engage in, carry on and operate anywhere and everywhere any and all business affairs, enterprises and undertakings which any citizen of the United States of America might engage in, carry on and operate, including any and all powers and rights of any such citizen to acquire, own, hold, deal in and dispose of any and all kinds of property, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, including powers and rights to mortgage and sell and otherwise dispose of any part or all of its own corporate assets and property, subject only to any specific restrictions imposed by the laws of the State of California or the laws of the United States of America, and further, in addition to the foregoing powers which any such citizen of the United States of America might have in engaging in, carrying on and operating any such business affairs, enterprise

or undertaking, to enjoy, exercise and hold any and all powers and rights which a corporation may enjoy, exercise and hold, including the holding and use of franchises, licenses and rights of acquiring property by eminent domain, subject to any specific restrictions imposed by the laws of the State of California or the laws of the United States of America.

To form, promote and assist financially or otherwise, companies, syndicates, partnerships and associations of all kinds, and to give any guarantee in connection therewith or otherwise for the payment of money or for the performance of any obligation or undertaking.

To borrow money and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business and powers or any part or parts thereof; provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation.

THIRD: That this corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

FOURTH: That the principal office for the transaction of business of the corporation shall be located in the

County of Los Angeles, State of California.

FIFTH: That the number of directors is three (3) and the names and addresses of the persons who are hereby appointed to act as the first directors of this corporation are as follows:

SIXTH: That the name of the existing unincorporated association being incorporated is YOUNG LADIES' RADIO LEAGUE.

SEVENTH: Membership in this corporation shall be unlimited as to number, and each and every individual who possesses the requisite qualifications, as provided in the By-Laws of this corporation and to whom this corporation offers and accepts application for membership, shall be a member of this corporation.

EIGHTH: Authority is hereby granted to the members of this corporation, entitled to vote, to change from time to time the authorized number of directors of this corporation by a duly adopted amendment of the By-Laws of this corporation.
