Dear YL's,

Some misunderstanding has arisen about the dues notices which are sent out to the girls each month their dues are due. To answer the many letters the officers of YLRL has received, we print the following explanation:

If your yearly dues are due in March 1945, a notice will be sent to you, by the secretary the first of March, reminding you that your years membership ends that month, and a request for you to renew it promptly. A questionnaire will also be sent to you, to be filled out properly and returned to the secretary with your check, cash or money order. Only one years dues may be credited to your name, if you send more than the fifty cents, the rest will be credited to your name as a donation. If no reply is received by the secretary within one month, a "Past Due" notice is sent to you. If this fails to bring any response, you will be carried on our rolls for 3 months, at the end of which time you will be dropped from YLRL.

Several girls have written saying they received no dues notice or past due notice. These notices are sent out first class mail to the last known address we have on record. If it is not returned to the secretary by the P. O. as "Unclaimed", we naturally assume the notice has reached the member. It is to avoid such instances that we urge all members to send any change of address either to their D/C or directly to the secretary at once. Your notification of change of address is the only way we have of knowing that you have moved.

If a member is dropped from YLRL by reason of failing to pay her dues, then wishes to join the organization again, she must be reinstated.

It is a difficult job to keep up with our many members during these trying times of moving from one state to another and the cooperation of all will be greatly appreciated in this matter.


