1. All licensed amateur radio operators, OM or YL, are eligible.
2. All contacts must be with YLs and must be postwar (from November 15, 1945).
3. Confirmation of contacts (QSL cards) with all states must be submitted to Lou Littlefield, W1MCW, 19 State Avenue, Queen Acres, Cape Elizabeth, Maine.
4. Return postage must be submitted for return of QSL cards.
5. YLRL will not be responsible in case of loss or damage to cards submitted.
(Note: Rule #2 - YL contacted must be a licensed amateur).
